

Short Excerpts Taken from Pope Francis Speaks to Families Words of Joy and Life

Dangers to the Family

The gift of the Holy Family was entrusted to St. Joseph so that he could care for it. Each of you, each of us—for I, too, am part of a family—is charged with caring forGod's plan. The angel of the Lord revealed to Joseph the dangers which threatened Jesus and Mary, forcing them to flee to Egypt and then to settle in Nazareth. So too, in our time, God calls upon us to recognize the dangers threatening our own families and to protect them from harm.

Let us be on guard against colonization by new ideologies. There are forms of ideologies. There are forms of ideological colonization which are out to destroy the family. They are not born of dreams, of prayers, of closeness to God or the mission which God gave us; they come from without, and for that reason I am saying that they are forms of colonization. Let's not lose the freedom of the mission which God has given us, the mission of the family. Just as our peoples, at a certain moment of their history, were mature enough to say "no" to all forms of political colonization, so too in our families we need to be very wise, very shrewd, very strong in order to say "no" to all attempts at an ideological colonization our families. We need to ask St. Joseph, the friend of the angel, to send us the inspiration to know when we can say "yes" and when we have to say "no".
